We are grateful that the CDC has recommended prioritizing vaccination for long-term care facilities and we received our first Pfizer vaccine shot on January 18th with the 2nd dose arriving February 8th. Our current and future residents/employees will continue to have prioritization for the vaccine via our scheduled vaccination clinics through March 1st.
